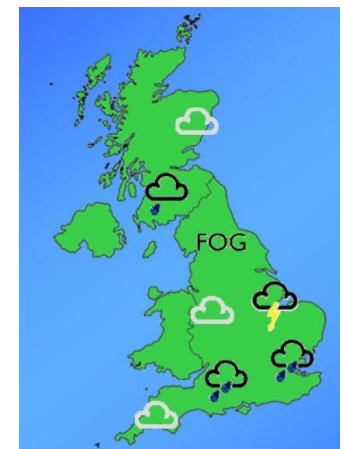


Wonderful Weather!

Using symbols is a **technique** that geographers use.

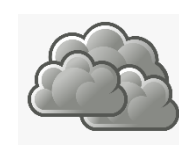
Weather symbols

frequently – happens often

symbols – pictures or signs instead of words

physical process – things that happen naturally

atmosphere – the gases that surround the Earth

technique – a way of doing something

extreme – much worse than normal

heatwave – when it is very hot for a long time

drought – when there is not much water

flood – large amount of water where it shouldn't be!

monsoon – very heavy rain in Asia

blizzard – heavy snow, usually with wind

gale/storm – strong winds

cyclone/hurricane – very strong winds, moving in circles

tornado/twister – a large column of rotating air
